Story: Family owned and operated, Pertaringa has branched out from its McLaren Vale roots to explore the uniqueness and diversity of South Australia's iconic wine growing regions. The cooler climate of the Adelaide Hills produces some of the best Sauvignon Blanc in Australia, and this beautifully crisp and vibrant wine is a perfect example of what this region has to offer.

Vintage: The 2016 vintage was in general very mild with low rainfall. The lack of rain looked like it would result in a quick harvest, but a big downpour in early February made sure the vintage was more evenly spread out. The yields were up on the couple of previous years and the quality is looking great.

Nose: The nose offers vibrant aromas of gooseberries, citrus and mango.

Palate: The palate is crisp and refreshing with notes of mango, green apples and racy acidity.

Pairing: A very versatile food wine, this wine goes really well with seafood and a variety of Asian cuisines.
