Vintage: The conditions throughout summer in South Australia were ideal for highlighting the sensational quality this state is capable of producing. The 2013 vintage was low yielding, resulting in exceptional wines with great intensity.

Nose: The nose offers aromas of rich plum and cherry with spicy notes of pepper, cloves and nutmeg.

Palate: The palate is elegant with violet, plum and black cherry notes, as well as hints of truffles and a fine tannin structure.

Pairing: Try this wine with a grass fed scotch fillet steak and grilled vegetables on the barbeque.
