Story: Family owned and operated, Pertaringa has branched out from its McLaren Vale roots to explore the uniqueness and diversity of South Australia's iconic wine growing regions. Cool climate Chardonnay from the Adelaide Hills is regarded as some of the best in Australia, producing elegant wines with bright fruit characters and lively acidity.

Vintage: The 2016 vintage was in general very mild with low rainfall. The lack of rain looked like it would result in a quick harvest, but a big downpour in early February made sure the vintage was more evenly spread out. The yields were up on the couple of previous years and the quality is looking great.

Nose: The nose is lively and youthful with aromas of citrus, peach and Granny Smith apple.

Palate: The palate is crisp and elegant with notes of lemon, green apples and hints of oak.

Pairing: The perfect white wine for any time of the year, try this Chardonnay with Chicken Cacciatore.

Cellaring: Drink now or to 2020
