## Shiraz 2016

### *South Australia*

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**Story:** Shiraz is synonymous with Australia and is grown in most regions from the warmest regions where it produces full-bodied, ripe and plummy wines, to cool regions where a spicy, peppery, medium-bodied wine is the result. The GMH Shiraz 2016 is from the McLaren Vale, Adelaide Hills and Langhorne Creek.

**Vintage:** The 2016 vintage was in general very mild with low rainfall. The lack of rain looked like it would result in a quick harvest, but a big downpour in early February made sure the vintage was more evenly spread out. The yields were up on the couple of previous years and the quality is looking great.

**Nose:** The nose is expressive and fruit forward with red cherries, plums and boysenberries, followed by hints of spice.

**Palate:** The palate is youthful and displays notes of plums, sour cherries and apricots with a fine tannin structure.

**Pairing:** Try this wine with a grass fed scotch fillet steak and grilled vegetables on the barbeque.

**Cellaring:** Drink now to 2024
