



K1 by *Geoff Hardy*

2016 Sauvignon Blanc *Adelaide Hills*

Story: The K1 Sauvignon Blanc vines are in a sandy loam area of the K1 vineyard, situated in the southern Adelaide Hills. The vines are trained to a single cordon and spur pruned to a low bud number to increase fruit quality.

Vintage: The 2016 vintage was in general very mild with low rainfall. The lack of rain looked like it would result in a quick harvest, but a big downpour in early February made sure the vintage was more evenly spread out. The yields were up on the couple of previous years and the quality is looking great.

Nose: The nose is vibrant with aromas of gooseberries, ruby grapefruit and green mango complemented by notes of elderflower and green peas.

Palate: The palate is clean and crisp with a linear acidity

Pairing: Ending on a drier note, this wine is perfect with Asian cuisine and seafood dishes.
