Story: Gruner Veltliner has found a new home in the cool southern Adelaide Hills where it produces white wines that capture both the old-world essence of Austria and the modern vibrancy and clarity of Australia.

Vintage: The 2016 vintage was in general very mild with low rainfall. The lack of rain looked like it would result in a quick harvest, but a big downpour in early February made sure the vintage was more evenly spread out. The yields were up on the couple of previous years and the quality is looking great.

Nose: The nose exhibits aromas of stone fruits and citrus, complemented by spicy notes.

Palate: The palate is beautifully complex with peach, rock melon and lemon, followed by additional floral notes and a lingering finish.

Pairing: Try with poached chicken with a black bean and coriander dressing

Cellaring: Drink now or to 2021
