

K1 Shiraz 2001



This wine is an excellent example of how well the variety performs in a cooler climate and its dense inky colour gives an immediate impression of its quality.

The nose exhibits an aroma of freshly picked mulberries and stewed plums along with a hedonistic combination of ground allspice, dark chocolate and roasted coffee beans.

Similar flavours can be found on the rich and generous palate that then linger long after swallowing. Quality French oak is evident in the soft, powdery tannins that coat the mouth and which lend spiciness and a hint of vanillin to the profile.

The wine finishes fresh and lively with harmonious acid giving the wine persistence.

Although enjoyable now, the combination of these qualities suggest this wine will age gracefully well into the next decade.

To allow the superb characters of this wine to show, we suggest decanting and/or breathing before service.
