Pinot Noir 2013

Adelaide Hills cool climate Pinot Noir has long been regarded as the best that South Australia can produce. The K1 vines are of low yield and are pruned to arched canes for extra light interception on the fruit and optimum balance. Hand harvesting the fruit ensures that the grapes are in top condition for the traditional vinification.

Lifted aromas of strawberries, talcum powder and cola are followed by more savoury notes of French truffle and freshly turned earth.

The palate is delicate and velvety with notes of cranberries, hints of spice and silky tannins to finish.

Pair with local favourite such as wild duck or enjoy a glass or two with family and friends.

Further cellaring of 5 to 8 years will bring out the savoury and earthy characters synonymous with high quality Pinots.

Variety 100% Pinot Noir, clones D5V12, D4V2 & Mariafeld

Region: 100% K1 Vineyard

Winemaking: Matured in 100% French barriques. 30% new oak, and 70% aged between 2 and 5 years.

Alcohol: 14% alc/vol

Total acidity: 6.12 g/L

pH: 3.47

Residual sugar: 2.2 g/L
