



K1 by *Geoff Hardy*

2017 Pinot Noir *Adelaide Hills*

Story: The K1 vines are of low yield and are pruned to arched canes for extra light interception on the fruit and optimum balance. Hand harvesting the fruit ensures that the grapes are in top condition for the traditional vinification.

Vintage: Spring and summer were cooler than normal with above average rainfall and the 2017 vintage happened much later than usual. The combination of those factors and dry weather for most of the harvest resulted in higher yields and excellent quality across regions.

Nose: The K1 Pinot Noir exhibits complex aromas of cherries and strawberries with a smidge of spice.

Palate: The palate is smooth and very drinkable with lashings of red berry flavours and elegant fine tannins on the drying finish.

Pairing: Try this wine with a wild duck dish or enjoy a glass or two with family and friends.

Oak maturation: 20% new French oak for 10 months.

Cellaring: Drink now or to 2025
